Creating Tribes Learning Communities in After School and Youth Development Programs

The purpose of this 12-hour experiential training is to prepare YOU, the after school youth worker, site director, or program coordinator, to develop a caring, learner-centered environment utilizing an active- learning approach. Returning, and new participants, will engage in the community-building process of Tribes, experiencing it's power to transform the learning environment into one which promotes human development, resiliency, social-emotional competence AND academic achievement.

Whether it's your first time, or you're returning to strengthen your skills and learn from others, you will walk away with new and effective ways of using multiple intelligences, brain compatible learning and cooperative methods.

*Participants will receive a copy of the 432 page book, **Reaching All by Creating Tribes Learning Communities**, by Jeanne Gibbs, a Certificate of Completion, and the materials to enable you to implement Tribes in your after-school community learning center.*
